

Help Hawaii's public schools



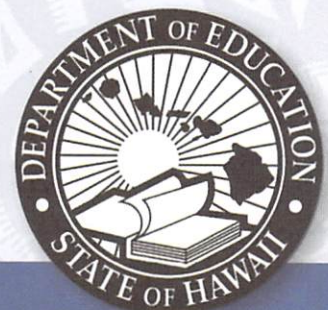
Dear Parent,

Do you live or work in a federal property (i.e. low-income housing, military installation/housing, federal building, national park)?

If yes, please pay close attention to a letter and survey your child will bring home in a few days. Your participation in the **Impact Aid Survey** helps secure valuable funds for Hawaii's public schools, including your child's. Here's how:

- Each year, Hawaii is unable to collect local taxes from tax-free federal properties. This means less money for public education.
- The federal government, however, partially reimburses Hawaii for the cost of educating federally connected students through so-called Impact Aid funds.
- The amount of Impact Aid schools receive is based on how many parents complete and return the survey to their child's school.
